Samoan Church

Project

To design and build Phase One of a church/administration area. The total square feet of the project is 12,488.

Project Details

The building site is located in Des Moines, Washington. The appearance of the building was designed to fit into a mixed-use neighborhood, with family homes, a large public school, and another church/school nearby.

Time to Complete

The building blueprints were approved in January 2005, the structure was delivered in April 2005, and fully completed in November 2005.

Special Features

This building utilized modular construction (administration/classrooms/foyer) and panelized construction (sanctuary). The sanctuary was erected first, the modular units were crane-set next, then the roof was erected over the entire structure. The administration portion featured 11' suspended ceilings, while the sanctuary featured 25' high painted sheetrock ceilings. The sanctuary also featured a concrete sloped floor, to allow parishioners to see the stage better.

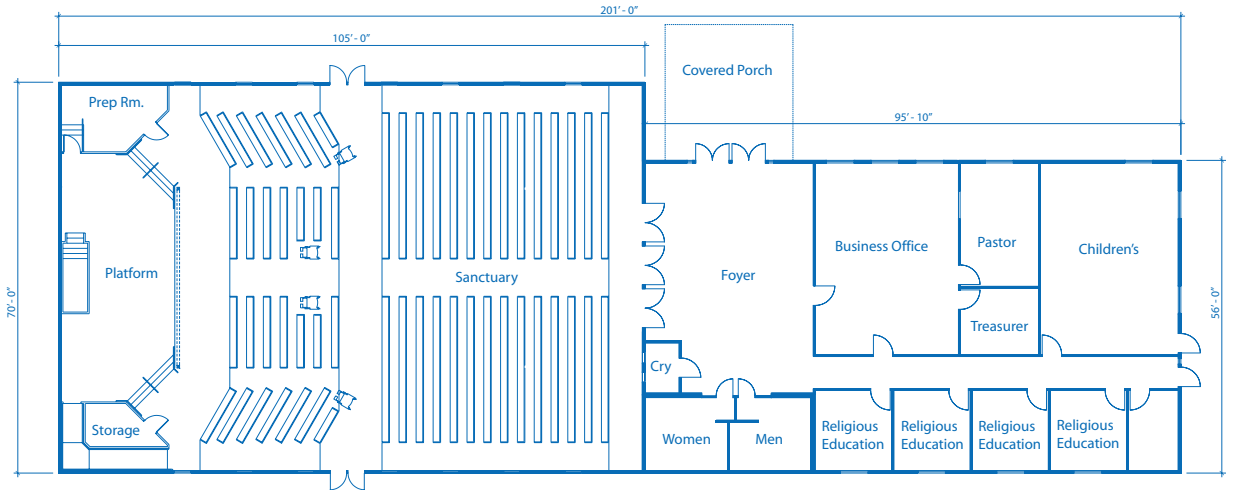
