Students submitted essays where they were evaluated by an independent committee based on merit, academic performance, financial need, community involvement and academic pursuits.

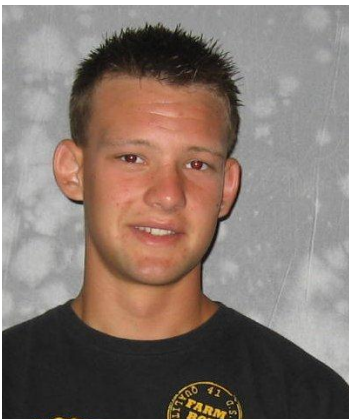
